Just bring yourself in comfortable clothes and meet **Sunday, September 20, 2:30 at the AASHE registration desk**. We will car pool to Washington Park for fun, camaraderie and Disc Golf. We will return by 5:30 p.m.

Disc golf is played like traditional golf, using flying discs instead of clubs. The object is to throw from a designated starting area (tee) into a target called a pole hole, in as few shots as possible. One stroke is counted for each throw of the disc. The winner is the disc golfer with the lowest score.

Washington Park Disc Golf Course Directions from Convention Center

1. Start out going SOUTH on S CAPITOL
2. Turn RIGHT onto W SOUTH ST.
3. Turn RIGHT onto S MISSOURI ST/S WEST ST. Continue to follow S WEST ST.
4. S WEST ST becomes N DR MARTIN LUTHER KING JR ST
5. Merge onto I-65 S
6. Merge onto I-70 E via EXIT 112A on the LEFT toward COLUMBUS OH
7. Take EXIT 85B toward NORTH KEYSTONE AVE
8. Merge onto N RURAL ST - N RURAL ST becomes KEYSTONE WAY
9. Turn right (east) on 30th Street
10. Turn North on Dearborn Street to parking lot on right

Description: Open park with rolling hills and large trees. This course demands a wide variety of shots. Very fun course. Concrete tees. 18 holes. 5260 ft
